Possibilities for researchers to participate in upcoming RAP meetings:

Option 1: Megan Farrelly, D6.1 (in person)

As part of an ongoing evaluation of the CRCWSC's activities, Dr Megan Farrelly would like to undertake interactive workshop activities with RAPs across the country in order to better understand the impact of CRCWSC outputs and activities. An important part of evaluating the impact of the CRCWSC is to try and capture the different pathways of influence in order to develop a credible causal chain to validate our claims of broader societal impact. The proposed evaluation workshop seeks to address this task by providing RAP members with an important opportunity to offer genuine feedback on their involvement with the CRCWSC. In particular, the aim of this workshop is to: (a) understand how various organisations are engaging with the CRCWSC; and (b) begin to describe the impact generated by CRCWSC research and engagement activities to date. The exercises will attempt to elicit this information in relation to the five domains of evaluation (appropriateness, effectiveness, efficiency, effectiveness, impact and sustainability) that underpin the CRCWSC's Evaluation and Learning Framework.
